

Preschool Narrative

Preschool data is not reflected on the CA Dashboard. Expulsions in preschool are no longer a common practice due to the enactment of Assembly Bill 752 which prohibits California State Preschool Programs from expelling children unless an exhaustive process aimed at supporting the child and family is followed and documented first. If the interventions and practices for evaluating the child's social emotional development along with creating a behavior plan don't resolve concerns, the preschool must help identify an alternative placement for the child.

Example: In the 2018-19 school year we have reduced the number of preschool expulsions in our program. We have 800 children enrolled in our program and in 2017-18 we had 10 expulsions compared to our 2018-19 school year, where we have had only 1 expulsion and the child expelled was placed in alternative placement and parents were given resources to help with supporting the child's behavior at home.
